"On 22 September 2007, I played a solo show at the Union Chapel in Islington, London. If you were there, thanks for coming - it was a great night among many great nights. It was about as relaxed as I have ever felt on a stage and I'm indebted to all who came and created such an atmosphere in such a beautiful little church. I'm thrilled to announce that the DVD of the concert is now ready; The Boom Boom Boys shot and edited it, I mixed it myself, and it looks and sounds great! The vibe was lovely and I think we've captured it. There's also bonus material of a handful of excerpts from my diary - a few interesting days including prison in Poland, the Pulp Fiction evening in San Diego and the bizarre 37 hour flight to Mexico City via most of America (so that the FBI could arrest Cat Stevens, and - very nearly - me too..)

Since 2006, **Steve Hogarth** has been doing some "H natural series" shows, piano only concerts in intimate settings.

On these occasions, Steve plays stripped-down versions of **Marillion** songs, some personal favorites and he also talks a lot. Each gig can be downloaded from his website.








*Naked In The Chapel* is a video document of one of these shows, on the 22th of September 2007 the Union Chapel in Islington, London. Hogarth himself says that "It was about as relaxed as I have ever felt on a stage..." and after viewing the DVD, I can confirm it was the case.

Music wise, the setlist is very interesting and the "piano only" versions of the songs are quite good, even though you should expect "slowed down" and very emotional incantations of the songs. The DVD is also very well filmed and recorded. Another thing you should expect is Steve talking. Using a "ball park figure", I would evaluate that he does it for about one third of the length of the DVD. He can be interesting and humorous, but I would not go as far as to say that I would feel like listening to him chatter on numerous occasions. A "music only" feature in the DVD Menu would have been appreciated, the "fast forward" remote key being the only way to skip the chatter and go directly to the music.

The bonus material is Steve reading from his diary, so the intimate experience can be extended. The DVD I

got was the "special bible pack edition", very good looking but, surprisingly, without a booklet included.

In conclusion, if you are a **Steve Hogarth** or **Marillion** fan and enjoy unplugged versions of songs, *Naked In The Chapel* is certainly for you. If also you feel like digging in the **Steve Hogarth** persona and want to know what makes him tick, *Naked In The Chapel* will certainly give you some intimate moments with him.
