## MARTHA REEVES IN CONCERT

**List Price: \$12.95; Quantum Leap.** Driven by Martha Reeves' soulful, brassy lead vocals, Martha and The Vandellas were one of Motown Records' earliest and most exciting vocal groups. Their first hit was a beat ballad "Come Get These Memories" and was Holland-Dozier-Holland's first collaboration as a songwriting team. The DVD also features special guest star Sam Moore.



## ROCK AND ROLL LEGENDS - THE PLATTERS, COASTERS

**List Price: \$12.95; Quantum Leap.** The Platters were one of the top vocal groups of the 1950's, selling 53 million records and being among the first doo-wop groups to be inducted into the Rock And Roll Hall of Fame. The Coasters comic vocals plus the writing and production of Jerry Leiber and Mike Stoller resulted in a string of wisecracking hits. By the end of the 50s, the Coasters were one of America's most popular Rock and Roll groups.
