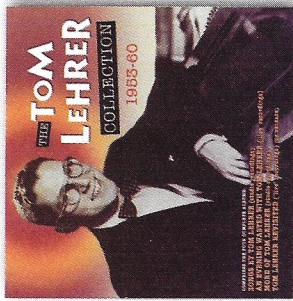

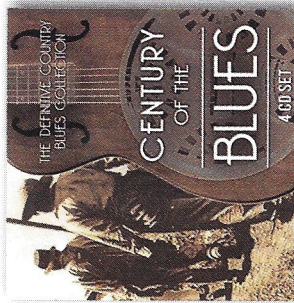

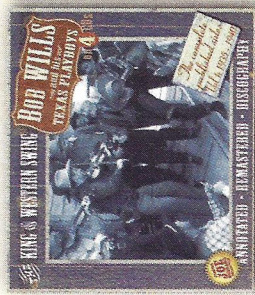


Bob Wills & His Texas Playboys: King of Western Swing 4-CD Set

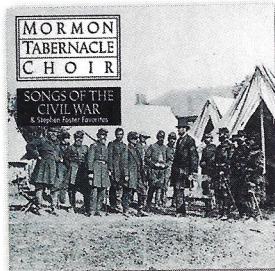

Bill Monroe and his Bluegrass Boys: Classics 1950-1958 4-CD Set

He was a true original with a distinctive slide guitar technique, and he performed a range of blues, spirituals and ballads in a powerful, intense, even primitive, fashion which uniquely captures the style and spirit of the genre. His recording career was cut short in 1934 due to his death from a heart ailment. This collection comprises his entire output, 60 remastered tracks in all, including "Pony Blues," "Prayer of Death," and "Tell Me Man Blues."

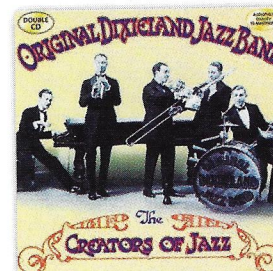
Original Dixieland Jazz Band: 75th Anniversary

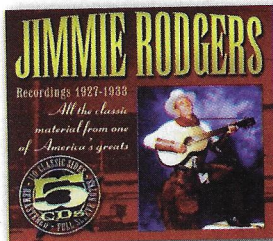


Jimmie Rodgers: Classics 1927-1933 5-CD Set

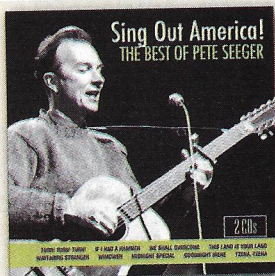
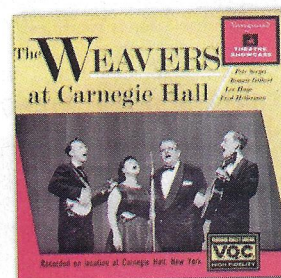


The Weavers: At Carnegie Hall

The Weavers—Ronnie Gilbert, Lee Hays (vocals), Fred Hellerman (vocals, guitar), Pete Seeger (vocals, banjo, recorder, mandolin) – were one of America's most popular folk bands but, in 1952, they were blacklisted by the House Un-American Activities Committee, forcing them to disband. Hear their legendary Carnegie Hall concert on Christmas Eve, 1955, when the Weavers re-united in the face of McCarthy-era persecution for this sold-out show. Twenty songs, including "Rock Island Line," "Wimoweh," "Darling Corey," "Goodnight Irene," "Kisses Sweeter Than Wine," and more. One of the finest concert recordings of all time, this is also one of the Weavers' best remembered albums.

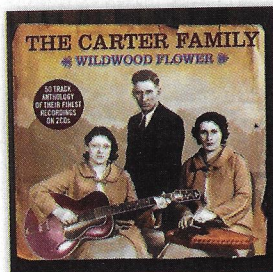
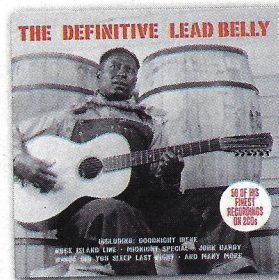
