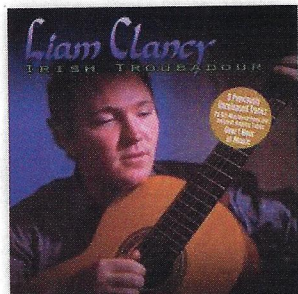
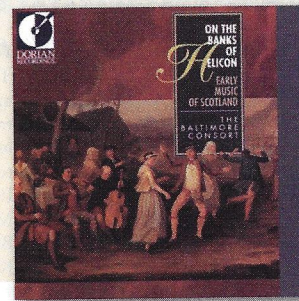


Early Music of Scotland: On the Banks of Helicon

His deep, rich voice bring beauty and resonance to songs such as "I'm a Freeborn Man," "Ten and Nine," the traditional "The Rocky Road to Dublin," the quietly bittersweet "Lang A-Growing," "Dirty Old Town," and more. With 23 tracks in all, fans of The Clancy Brothers and Irish folk music alike will find this to be a comforting and beautiful selection.

This four-disc set shows Watson at the height of his powers, from his blazing 1964 original Vanguard album to nine numbers recorded live at the Newport Folk Festival. There's plenty of clean, lightning-quick flatpicking here, of course, but The Vanguard Years also showcases Watson's skills on the five-string banjo and rack harmonica as well as his warm and personable voice. Sixty four classic tracks in all including 17 unreleased performances recorded live at the 1971 Winfield, Kansas flatpicking championships.

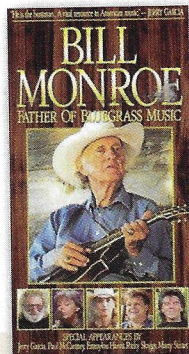
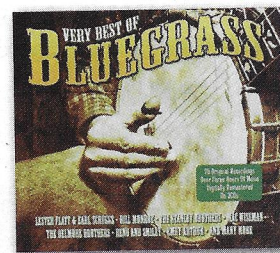


The Very Best of Bluegrass 3-CD Set

The early days of bluegrass were "men only." Thank goodness, times have changed, and women artists are now accepted on their own terms. This 19-track all-girl bluegrass compilation is a delightful celebration of several generations of female bluegrass artists including fan favorites such as Alison Krauss and the Cox Family, and less well-known artists such as Claire Lynch ("If Wishes Were Horses"), Rhonda Vincent' on her rocking "Lonesome Wind Blues," the hard-edged mountain sound of Phyllis Boyens (backed up by Hazel Dickens and the Johnson Mountain Boys), and the clawhammer banjo-powered "Comin' Down From God" by Carol Elizabeth Jones. This is as real as bluegrass music gets.

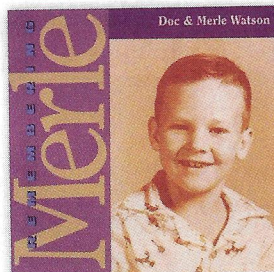
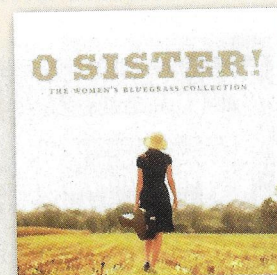

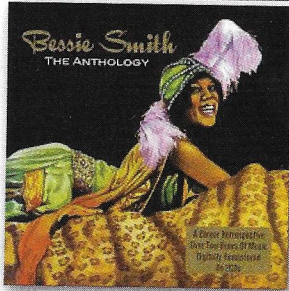
Doc and Merle Watson: Remembering Merle

Eddy Merle Watson (1949-1985) was widely recognized as one of the best flat-picking and slide guitarists of his generation, and well known for his performances with his father, Doc Watson. Merle played and recorded albums together with his father from age 15 until his death in a tractor accident 20 years later. On this beautiful tribute, here are 17 recordings made at various Doc & Merle concerts between 1970 and 1976. 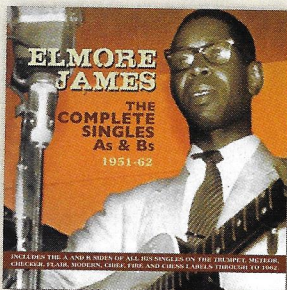
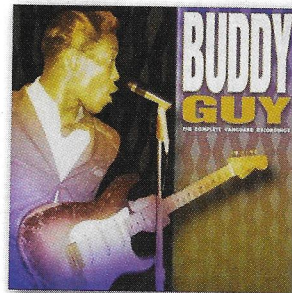


Buddy Guy: The Complete Vanguard Recordings 3-CD Set

This 3-CD box set is a compilation of Buddy Guy's three albums on the Vanguard label. Performing alongside Buddy were many of Chicago's best musicians including Otis Spann, A.C. Reed and Junior Wells. The first album in this box set is *A Man and the Blues*, a set that simmers with slow blues roots and down-home covers like "Money (That's What I Want)" and "Poison Ivy." The second CD, *This Is Buddy Guy*, was recorded live in Berkeley in 1968 and features Buddy's flashy guitar solos and sweet vocals. The final album, *Hold That Plane!*, recorded in 1970, showcases a touch of funk in the cover of "Watermelon Man," plus more classic Guy guitar solo nuggets. Get this set while you can!

Born in Richland, Mississippi, in 1918, Elmore James didn't record until 1951 and died just 11 short years later - yet his influence was enormous. James' distinctive slide-guitar style proved even more popular than his records, influencing generations of six-string pluckers and winning disciples like Fleetwood Mac's Jeremy Spencer who modeled his entire sound and style on his idol. Featured here are 41 of Elmore's finest recordings including "Dust My Broom," "Please Find My Baby," "Early in the Morning," "Hand In Hand," and "It Hurts Me Too."
