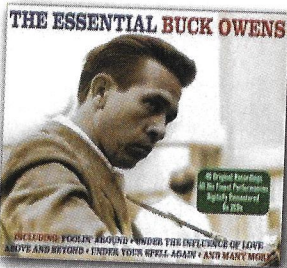
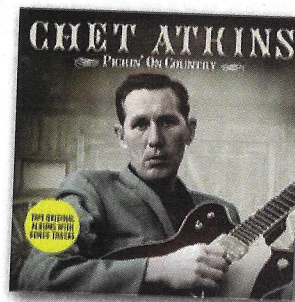


Chet Atkins: Pickin' on Country 2-CD Set

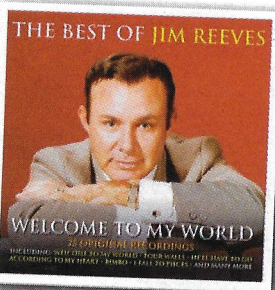
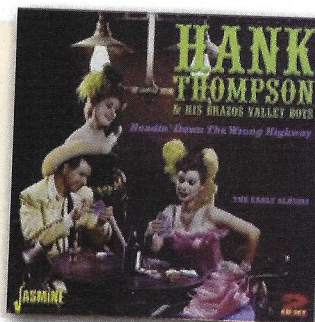


Hank Thompson & His Brazos Valley Boys: The Early Albums 2-CD Set

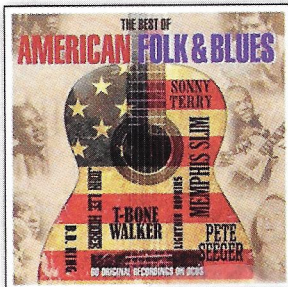
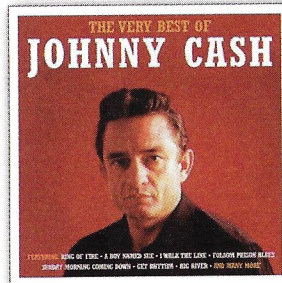


Johnny Cash: The Very Best 3-CD Set
