Tangerine Dream on DVD, plus more soundtracks



A rare concert performance makes its debut on DVD from Respect Records / MVD Visual.
Directed by Tony Palmer, Tangerine Dream:
Live at Coventry Cathedral is a montage of footage from the 1975 concert where the trio – Edgar Froese, Christopher Frank, and Peter Baumann – performed material from their Richochet album. With the exception of Palmer's own website, this title is barely acknowledged online, and doesn't even appear

in the director's **IMDB** filmography.

- <u>Justice League: The New Frontier</u> (2008) from La-La Land Records, featuring the bulk of Kevin Manthei's fun score to the new feature-length film that has Earth (us) threatened by a slimy ship sprouting all manor of dino-like lizards.
