— triumph. Originally issued on video in 1995, the long-delayed DVD version boasts a staggering amount of bonus material and cleaned-up audio and video. In addition to the 22-song concert featuring “Dark Side of the Moon” in its entirety the set includes superb packaging, backstage footage, additional concert material, the band’s induction into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and super high-

quality audio options for those with tricked-out systems.

Porcupine Tree, “Arriving Somewhere”: Of the many acts to take cues from Pink Floyd, Porcupine Tree is among those more apt to take stylistic detours. This live DVD, shot in October 2005, focuses on the band’s recent, harder material, which may disappoint longtime fans. Then again, this is the band’s first home-video release, so older, archival stuff may be in the pipeline.

The “Under Review” series: The sleeves on these British

DVD series are slightly misleading, in that they often boast rare live material from the featured artist. But these aren’t collections of full clips. They’re feature-length, unauthorized documentaries that incorporate portions of performances, often just a verse and chorus. Still, the DVDs make for fascinating viewing, especially for those who don’t mind eggheady Brits freely pontificating. The Velvet Underground installment is essential, thanks to its insightful interviews with band members Moe Tucker and Doug Yule. Volumes on Queen, Syd Barrett, Captain Beefheart, the

Smiths and Kate Bush are also worth a look.

Garth Brooks, “The Entertainer”: This generous five-DVD set features four key concerts from the country superstar, including gigs from 1991 and 1993 that were originally aired on NBC and his historical 1997 performance in New York’s Central Park. The fifth disc includes 15 music videos, three of which are exclusive to this box. It’s a steal at \$20, but it’s available only at Wal-Mart.

Kiss, “Kissology Vol. 1: 1974-1977”: Now that the

hardcore followers have had a few weeks to dig in to this juicy collection of TV and concert footage, a few complaints have surfaced, primarily that some of the video isn’t quite up to par technologically and has been seen elsewhere (on official releases and bootlegs) in finer quality. (This being Kiss, there’s probably a re-mastered version waiting in the wings.) But even so, these shows capture the band at its fire-breathing, blood-spewing peak, and the extras are a exceptional, particularly a hilarious 1974 Gene Simmons appearance on “The Mike Douglas Show.”
