David Bowie's 1976-1979 "Berlin Trilogy" is a wonderful period in the rock chameleon's legacy, so experimental and adventurous. This addition to the "Under Review" series is a superbly packaged collection of commentary from Dieter Moebius, Michael Rother, former members of Neu! and Cluster. Though some of the hardcore fans balk at these compilations, David Bowie: Under Review 1976-1979 The Berlin Trilogy is actually quite effective and highly interesting. Like so many of his contemporaries, Bowie's life changes make certain aspects of his body of work fixed in time, some more innovative than others. This is one of those phases that demands more attention and the Independent Critical Analysis makes for a good addition to the Bowie library.
