The US music business' response to the British 'Invasion, the Byrds eventually got more recognition through performing Dylan covers than they did imitating the Beatles. It's hard to believe that these guys recorded a cover of "House of the Rising Sun" in their Beatle haircuts and matching suits – still, the type of song was not a typical Beatles love song. In the Extras guitarist Jerry Cole recalls tales of Phil Spector, producer and avid gun collector, who on one occasion showed off his .45s, then his accordion. Cole also talks about Charles Manson – "spooky." Live and studio recordings, notably including "Mr. Spaceman."
