It wasn't until this music made its way to US soil - mainly,

the Bay Area - that thrash was born.

Aural Amphetamine is a great DVD that takes an in depth look at that glorious head-banging music we all know and love, and the bands that made it what it is today. This disc is full of classic footage from **Metallica**, **Slayer** and others, and is also full of cool interviews with the guys that made it as well as the guys that covered it. All in all, a great DVD and history lesson for the newbies out there.
