



The **Korn** DVD *Live At Montreux* features a 13-song, 75-minute concert (including covers of **Pink Floyd**'s "Another Brick In The Wall" and **Metallica**'s "One") filmed in July 2004 at Switzerland's Montreux Jazz Festival with the band's original lineup. . . . **Tesla**'s *Comin' Atcha Live! 2008* has over two hours of live music (filmed at the sold-out Myth Nightclub in Maplewood, Minn., on Feb. 22), more than 60 minutes of behind-the-scenes footage and other never before seen clips. Also featured is the world premiere of the song "Dear Pvt. Ledbetter," a tune honoring the troops that will be on the next Tesla CD, which is expected to drop in September. . . . **Lamb Of God**'s 2-disc set *Walk With Me In Hell* includes over five hours of footage, including the documentaries "Walk With Me In Hell" and "Making Of *Sacrament*," performance clips, music videos, interviews, featurettes and more. "We're onstage for 90 minutes a day," says drummer **Chris Adler**. "People want to know what's going on for the other 22-and-a-half hours. It's not always limousines and champagne. . . This is an entire new level of documentary taking you on an intense, worldwide journey with us." . . . MVD Visual has recently released two new DVDs for music lovers: *Iron Maiden and The New Wave Of British Heavy Metal* is a documentary chronicling the 1970's NWOBHM movement that features rare live and studio footage, interviews and more from bands that defined the era, including Maiden, **Saxon**, **Samson**, **Praying Mantis**, **Diamond Head** and others; and **Hanoi Rocks'** *The Nottingham Tapes* contains a concert the group filmed on April 23, 1984, at England's Palais.
