



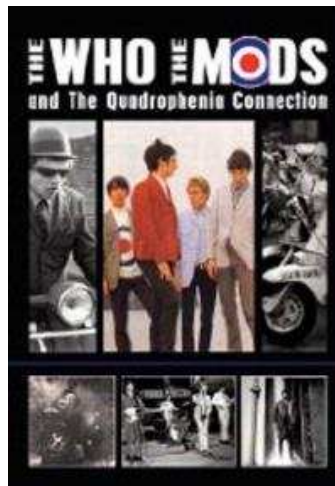

**The Who**

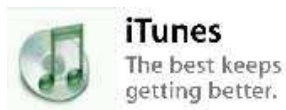
**The Who, The Mods and the Quadrophenia Connection DVD**
