TV on DVD has returned with a vengeance. In fact, it's pushed any mainstream releases off the date this week.

Usual rules apply: synopses are taken from the press releases, snarky commentary is extra, and preview links go to Apple.com. And just in case you were wondering, the DVD prices are the listed retail prices. You can get them cheaper if you buy at discount stores or online.

Agatha Christie's Marple, Series 5

Acorn Media, 267 minutes, 3 episodes, 4 discs, \$49.99

Julia McKenzie returns as Miss Marple, solving murder mysteries in 1950s England. Extras: interviews, featurettes,

Brothers and Sisters: The Complete Fourth Season

ABC Studios, 1,032 minutes, 24 episodes, \$45.99

Fourth season of the family drama with matriarch Nora (Sally Field) trying to keep track of her five adult children as they go through the trials and tribulations of modern life. Also stars Rob Lowe, Calista Flockhart and Rachel Griffiths. Extras: bloopers, deleted scenes, two featurettes.

The Evil Dead (Limited Edition)

Anchor Bay, 85 minutes, not rated, \$29.99 (BD debut)

Director Sam Raimi's first horror classic makes it's BD debut with two new transfers in the 1:85 ratio and the original 1:33 ratio. Five college friends, including Ash (fan favorite Bruce Campbell) travel to a remote cabin and find a cassette tape with instructions to revive evil spirits. They play the tape. Bad idea. Extras: new commentary with Raimi, Campbell and producer Robert Tapert. Bonus conventional DVD includes six featurettes previously released on other DVD versions.

Flashforward: The Complete Series

ABC Studios, 1946 minutes, 22 episodes, 5 discs, \$59.99

Short-lived series had an interesting premise: everyone on Earth blacks out for the same 2 minutes and seven seconds on April 29, 2010. All of them (except those who died as a result of being in a moving vehicle when it crashed at high speed or some sort) got a glimpse of their future. Wonder if they saw the series ending after only 22 episodes? Or that ABC Studios would try the "Part 1" season DVD trick, only to release a "complete" set later? No word if you'll be able to trade in your "Part 1" set. Extras: several featurettes, commentary, blooper reel, deleted scenes.

For My Wife: The Making of an Activist for Marriage Equality

Cinema Libre, 60 minutes, \$19.95

Documentary focuses on Charlene Strong, a woman who fought for domestic partnership legislation in Washington State after her wife died tragically in 2006 and she was not allowed to be at her side. Extras: interview with Gloria Steinem, music mySA video, podcast, filmmaker featurette

Go, Diego, Go!: Diego's Ultimate Rescue League

Nickelodeon/Paramount, 94 minutes, 3 episodes, \$16.99

The intrepid adventurer for the pre-school set assembles a team to rescue animals in danger. No extras listed.

House: Season Six

Universal, 21 episodes, 5 discs

DVD: \$59.98

BD: \$74.98

The acerbic House (Hugh Laurie) is trying to get his license back in this season, while his co-workers deal with the staff shakeups, moral dilemmas and House himself. Extras: featurettes, commentary. BD adds BD-Live capacity.
