It's certainly an interesting watch, whatever you musical preferences, but a series running out at around 650 minutes over 13 episodes doesn't come cheap. For your hard earned cash you get a 5 dvd box set that includes some extras in the form of bonus songs, outtakes and backstage footage, rehearsal footage, and a stills gallery. And, of course a 28 page booklet.

I'd hardly class it as an essential purchase. On the other hand if you're a Costello fan (and there are many) it's probably a must just for all the collaborations. And if you don't like football, it's an alternative to the World Cup.
