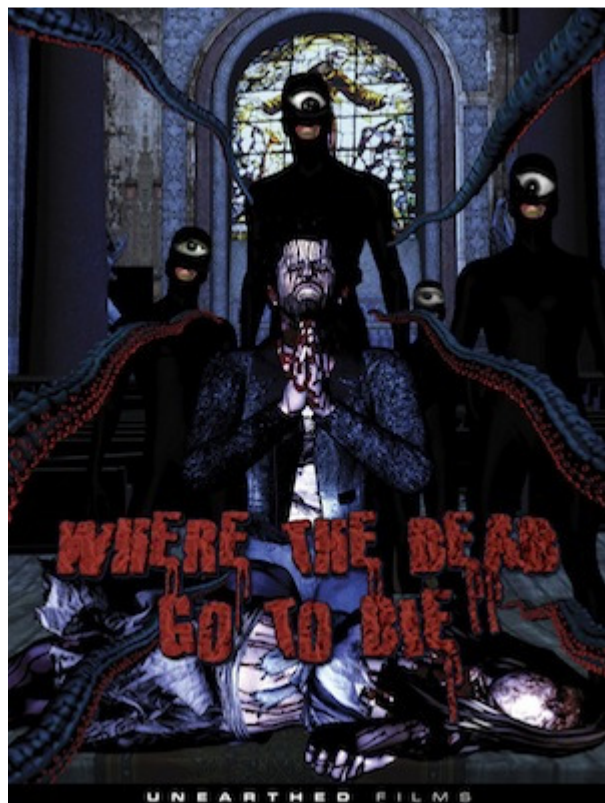


Where The Dead Go To Die
