Plot-Almost like a cartoon version of Creepshow with satanic overtones. Labby is a talking dog, that brings three people on a trip thru their minds and dimensions in 3 different stories. Story 2 is called Liquid Memories- a memory stealing junkie living inside an abandoned church, steals the memory of a dead prostitute. Story 3 is called The Masks that monsters wear-Labby attempts to help Ralph court the girl across the street, who is an unwilling participant in her father's child porn tape trading ring.

Review-What kind of sick minds think up these ideas? Most importantly, what kind of sick minds love these ideas, once they are presented? This film is not for everyone, hold on let me rephrase this... this film is not for anyone.
