

Add in a memory stealing junkie living inside an abandoned church and you have 90 minutes of pure mind melting insanity!



What we have here is a film that is a products of an Xbox Kinect motion capture. Which is on one hand really kinda cool and different. Then on the other hand it causes some awkward and slow-ish animation at times. You also got a plot that circles around child pron and other fun for the whole family issues. With scenes like a kid having sex with a demon dog all the while the dog is having sex with the kid's dead mother, you might need to expect a lot of shocking stuff overall. 





