



Whether they are the “world’s greatest reggae band” is open for debate, but there aren’t many others around better than Steel Pulse. They also haven’t lost any of their energy or conviction, despite being around now over three decades (33 years).

Lead vocalist David Hinds remains a powerful and extremely charismatic performer, and they’ve never strayed from the musical path of roots reggae, and the new DVD *Door of No Return* (MVD) follows their 1999 performance in Senegal when they were part of the Rock Against Racism movement.

Director Michel Moreau skillfully blended long and tight shots, revealing through close-ups and also panoramic views their on-stage tightness and energy. He’s also included several revealing interviews, including one with Hinds that offers some very frank and honest opinions about the music industry in general, and the reggae world specifically.
