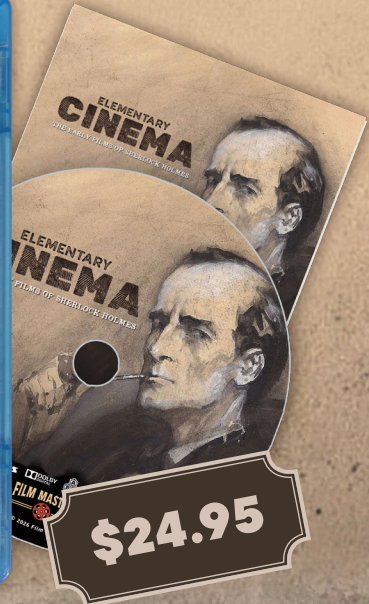
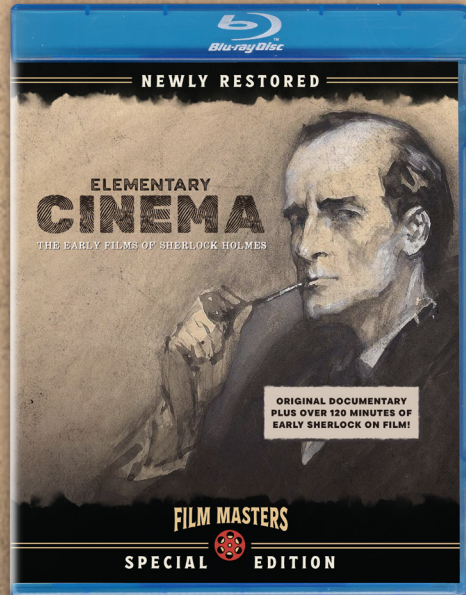


SEE SOME OF THE EARLIEST DEPICTIONS OF THE MOST FAMOUS LITERARY DETECTIVE!
